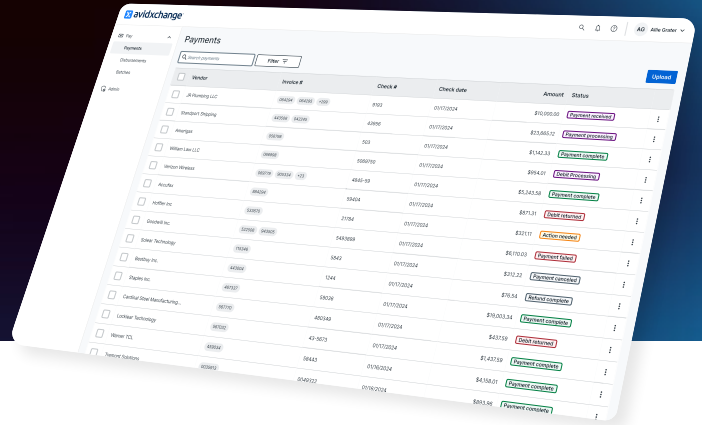


From Shortlist to Smart Choice: How to Evaluate Payment Automation Providers
